MANAGER'S NOTES**AMP 1 and AMP 2 / Directors: Susan Gay and Lashunda Hill****VERIFICATIONS FOR SOCIAL SECURITY:**

The Social Security Administration is asking that you do not come to the local office to get a verification of income. The Housing Authority will accept the letter that comes to you in the mail in December with the income for the following year. You can bring it in when you receive it, and we will copy and keep it on file. There are also other ways to get proof of Social Security income:

1. Call 1-800-772-1213
2. Set up an online account and you can get the information any time you wish.

The Housing Authority has a kiosk with step-by-step instructions on how to set up the account and a printer to print the information. This is a free service we offer the resident.

SMOKING: Reminder: Smoking at the developments must be twenty-five feet from the doors and windows. There should be no smoking in the breezeways at 840 N. Adams. Please carry an ashtray or coffee can to dispose of your cigarette butts after smoking.

FALL LEAF SEASON: Families are responsible for raking their own leaves. We ask that you bag your own leaves, and we will remove them for you. The Housing Authority will charge a fee if we have to rake your leaves. We have bags at the office we will give you. We will also loan you a rake, if you need one.

GUESTS; As in accordance with your lease, residents have **14 days per year of visitation.** This is a total of all visitors, each day. If you would like to add someone to your lease, contact our office. Violators will receive a written notice of lease violation, failure to comply with lease, could result in lease termination!

PETS: Visiting Pets are not permitted on Housing Authority Property. No animal shall be permitted to roam freely outdoors. When the pet is taken outside, the animal must be on a leash and under the direct control of the owner.

HAULING: Please call the office when you need something hauled. Do not put furniture in the dumpster or beside the dumpster.

DISPOSAL OF FOOD PRODUCTS: Please do not dump grease or left over food on the Housing Authority grounds. This attracts mice, rats, and other animals to come up around your home or come into your home.

DUMPSTERS: Do not overfill or block the dumpsters and make sure you close the lid. Please make sure your garbage bags go inside the dumpsters and not on the ground.

SENIOR NEWS**DIRECTOR: Rachel Jackson****Become A Senior Companion:**

You know how much you value your independence in your life. Now you can help others stay independent, too! By becoming a Senior Companion, you help others stay independent for as long as possible.

- **What's Expected:** light housekeeping, meal preparation, shopping/errands, companionship, and respect.
- **Hours Served:** A minimum of 20 hours a week, 4 hours a day.
- **Benefits:** As a volunteer you will receive paid training and earn \$250 + (tax - free) per month. This means that this income would not be counted as part of the income that you have to report.
- **Requirements:** Volunteers must be 55 or older and meet the income eligible requirements.

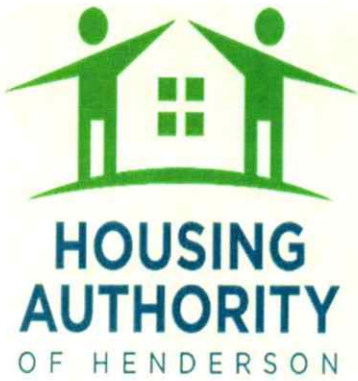
