- Never attempt to make your own fireworks.
- Keep yourself and your child away from other people who are using sparklers or lighting their own fireworksbystanders are more frequently injured by fireworks than the people who use them.
- Have water near for emergencies and for pouring on fireworks.
- Know where the closest phone is located-or carry a cell phone in case a fire occurs, and the fire department is needed.

#### No SWIMMING POOLS are allowed!

Children: Children are out of school. Please slow down when you are driving through the developments.

Complaints: If you are having an issue with a neighbor who is breaking the law, call the police department and give your manager a written complaint. It restricts the Property Manager from enforcing the lease agreement if there is no written complaint.

**Pets:** Residents are responsible to pickup pet waste as it occurs and dispose of it properly. Please do not fee stray cats and animals.

Parking: Do not park cars on the grass or sidewalks.


Trash: Please bag all trash and tie it closed to help eliminate odors. Place trash bags in dumpsters.

**Friendly Reminder:** Car washing, swimming pools, or hooking hoses or sprinklers with water from your apartment is not allowed, per your lease.

**Reminder:** HUD implemented a rule that requires all Housing Authorities to have a smoke free policy, effective June 5, 2017. This policy states no smoking in any Public Housing Apartment is allowed and smoking outside must be 25 feet away from and door or window.

We will terminate leases of those who continue to smoke in the non-smoking apartments.

- Birth Certificates must be provided for all household members and a photo ID for all adults.
- If anyone is pregnant a statement must be presented as to due date.
- For Public Housing you must have proof of income. There
  may also be other documents that may be
  needed. You can come to the office and pick up a list that
  show what other documents will be needed.
