Children- are going back to school, please **slow down** when you are driving through the developments.

Complaints-If you are having an issue with a neighbor who is **breaking the law call the police department**, and **give your manager a written complaint**, without a written complaint it restricts the Property Manager in enforcing the lease.

Reminder: Pets-resident is responsible to pick up pet waste as it occurs. Remember all pets must have an authorized pet permit displayed on their refrigerator. If you do not have a pet permit you must contact the main office to get one.

Parking- Do not park cars on the grass or sidewalks. Sidewalks are for walking or bike riding.

Please bag all trash and tie it closed to keep the smell down and flies out when throwing it in the dumpsters. Please place all trash in the dumpsters and not leave setting beside or on the dumpster.

Please remember that **car washing, pools, or hooking hoses or sprinklers** with water from your apt is not allowed, per your lease.

As in accordance with your lease, residents have **14 days per year of visitation**. This is a total of all visitors, each day. If you would like to add someone to your lease, contact our office. Violators will be given a lease violation notice. Residents who allow guests to stay past the 14 day limit are subject to lease termination.

Reminder HUD implemented a rule that requires all Housing Authorities to have a smoke free policy, effective June 5, 2017. This policy states no smoking in any Public Housing Apartment is allowed and smoking outside must be 25 feet away from and door or window.

We will terminate leases of those who continue to smoke in the non-smoking apartments.
