

TIME FOR FALL LI-HEAP SIGN-UPS

Fall Li-heap sign-ups will be held on October 24th and 25th.

To be eligible to register, you will need the following items:

- 1. Picture ID(s)
- Proof of Income (SS letter, SSI letter, SSD letter, 2024 tax return, or child support statement from the court for September)
- 3. Social Security Card(s)

You must have all of these items to sign up.

If any of the required documents are missing, you will not be able to register.

Please call in work orders as they happen. Do not wait until 4 PM to report a work order and do not place work orders online.

TRASH DUMPSTERS

Please use both sides of the dumpsters. If the side you open is full, please use the other side.

SMOKING

A reminder that smoking on the property must be done at least 25 feet from doors and windows. Smoking is not allowed in the breezeways at 840 N. Adams. Please carry an ashtray or coffee can to store your cigarette butts after smoking.

FALL LEAF SEASON

Residents are responsible for raking and bagging their own leaves. The Housing Authority will remove bagged leaves. If we have to rake your leaves, a fee will be charged. We have bags available at the office and can loan you a rake if needed.

GUESTS

As per your lease, residents are allowed a total of 14 visitor days per year. This is the total for all visitors combined. If you would like to add someone to your lease, please contact our office. Violators will receive a written notice for lease violation, and failure to comply may result in lease termination.

PFTS

Visiting pets are not permitted on Housing Authority property. Pets must always be on a leash held by the resident. All pet owners must pick up pet waste.

Parking

Do not park cars on the grass or sidewalks. Sidewalks are for walking or bike riding. There are no assigned parking spaces.

HAULING

Please call the office if you need something hauled away. Do not place furniture in or beside the dumpsters.
