The Housing Authority of Henderson maintenance department is processing and performing all routine and non-routine work orders. <u>Please continue to call in all workorders</u> needed in your unit.

NIGHT AND WEEKENDS EMERGENCY CALLS

In the event there is an emergency after work hours or weekends, please call the office at 827-1294, where an answering service operator will assist you. Please be sure to give all the following information to the operator:

- Name
- Address
- Telephone number
- Nature of your emergency

Maintenance personnel may call you to obtain additional information.

Please do not call Maintenance Personnel at their homes.

The Housing Authority recognizes the following as emergencies:

- Gas leaks
- No electricity
- · No heat in extreme cold weather
- No air conditioning (elderly and health conditions)
- Broken water lines
- Hot water tank leaking
- Stopped up commode
- Stopped up sewer
- Smoke alarm/Carbon Monoxide Detector not working
- Refrigerator inoperable
- Lock out

Anytime an emergency call is made, and it is determined by the Housing Authority that an emergency did not exist, you may be charged a \$25.00 fee for the non-emergency call out.

Smoking Policy

If you or your guests smoke, it must be 25 feet from any door or window.

Grass Mowing

Grass cutting season is here, please keep personal belongings out of yard area to allow the mowing crew to do their work.

Stray Animals on Property

Do not feed stray animals on the property or near the property.

Pets

This is reminder of the pet policy regarding cleaning up after your pet and HAH policy and your lease.

- A. All residents with pets shall comply with the following:
 - 18. Residents are solely responsible for <u>cleaning up of all pet waste</u>, if any, inside or outside the apartment and on Public Housing property...

Spring Cleaning

It is the resident's responsibility to clean mildew from doors, windows, window sills, showers, bathroom walls/ceilings on a regular basis. We often get calls from residents that have neglected cleaning these areas and feel that there is something wrong with their walls, plumbing, doors, etc, when it is most often a lack of regular and adequate cleaning. For cleaning these areas, the following is helpful information and will help you in cleaning the doors, walls, shower, walls, window sills, etc...

- Mix ¼ cup of bleach to 1 gallon of water in a proper size container
- Using a sponge or cloth rag wipe down the doors, doorframes, shower and bathroom walls, etc.
- Allow to dry and repeat as necessary
- Do not use any type of scraping tool, including metal or plastic bristle brushes, steel wool pads, etc. on the painted surfaces

This should take care of the problem. Once the buildup has been removed, this should last for some time. It may be necessary to repeat the above steps if the mildew/mold returns. If the steps above do not remove the buildup, please contact the office.

Children

Spring has arrived and more children are playing outside. Please slow down and watch closely. Parents, please provide adequate supervision for young children.

Please make sure that any telephone number changes are reported to the front desk so your information can be updated.

Laundry at 840 N. Adams And Fagan Hall

Housing Authority Laundromats are for <u>resident use only</u>. This is the only way we can keep the price at fifty cents. **THE HOUSING AUTHORITY LOSES MONEY ON EVERY LOAD**. Residents bringing in outside laundry or family member's laundry is not allowed.

Rent

Rent is due on the 1st of every month and late after the 10th of the month. Please pay your rent timely for a good reflection of your payment history for future references.

Interim Income Changes

How soon do I need to report my income change? The head of household needs to report all changes in all household income and any family composition change within 10 days. Failure to report changes, going back to work/ receiving unemployment benefits/ receiving child support, may result in the household having to repay any monies due, lease violation being issued, or possibly... a lease termination.

Make sure all income changes are reported by the 25th of each month in order to adjust your rent for the following month. We do not process same month rent changes.

Guests

As in accordance with your lease, residents have <u>14 days per year of visitation</u>. This is a total of all visitors, each day. If you would like to add someone to your lease, contact our office. Violators of this policy will be given a warning of lease violation. Failure to comply with your lease could result in lease termination.

Workorders

Please call your work orders into the front desk. <u>Do not email or leave them on a voice mail.</u> If a staff member has the day off, or is on vacation, your work order request may not get addressed timely.
