NEW SMOKE DETECTOR REQUIREMENT

THE HOUSING AUTHORITY TAKES PROACTIVE STEPS TO MEET THE REQUIREMENTS OF THE NATIONAL STANDARDS FOR THE PHYSICAL INSPECTIONS OF REAL ESTATE (NSPIRE).

Beginning January 1, 2025, all smoke detectors that are solely battery-operated must meet the following requirements:

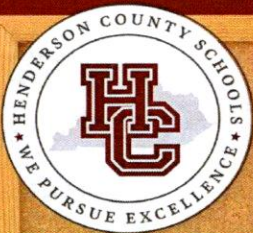
- ✓ 10-year, non-rechargeable, non-replaceable primary battery
- ✓ Sealed and tamper-resistant design (commonly known as a "sealed 10-year smoke alarm")

Under the new NSPIRE inspection standards, smoke detectors/alarms must be installed in the following locations within dwelling units:

- ✓ Inside each sleeping room (e.g., bedroom)
- ✓ Outside each sleeping room
- ✓ On every level of the dwelling unit
- ✗ Not within 10 feet of a cooking appliance
- ✗ Not within 3 feet of ceiling fans, air ducts, exterior doors, or windows.

Housing Authority Contractors will need to enter each unit to determine if the existing detectors meet the requirements of the National Standards for the Physical Inspection of Real Estate (NSPIRE) and continue to install new smoke detectors as outlined in compliance with NSPIRE and the H.R. 7981, Public and Federally Assisted Housing Fire Safety Act of 2022.

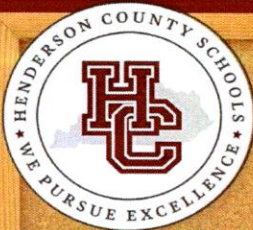

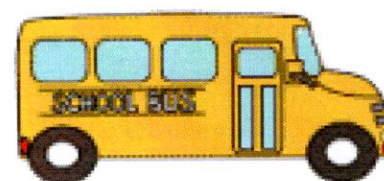

SMOKING

Reminder smoking at the developments must be twenty-five feet from the doors and windows. There should be no smoking in the breezeways at 840 N. Adams. Please carry an ashtray or coffee can to store your butts in after smoking.

FALL LEAF SEASON

Families are responsible for raking their own leaves. We ask that you bag your own leaves, and we will remove them for you. The Housing Authority will charge you if they have to rake your leaves. We have bags at the office we will give you and we will loan you a rake if you need one.

GUEST

As in accordance with your lease, residents have **14 days per year of visitation**. This is a total of all visitors, each day. If you would like to add someone to your lease, contact our office. Violators will receive a written notice of lease violation, failure to comply with lease, could result in lease termination!

PETS

Visiting Pets are not permitted on Housing Authority Property.

Pets must be on a leash that is always held by the resident.

HAULING

Please call the office when you need something hauled off. Do not put furniture in the dumpster or beside the dumpster.

- Educational Games: Play "Math Bingo" or "Word Search Races" together. These games promote learning while having fun as a family.

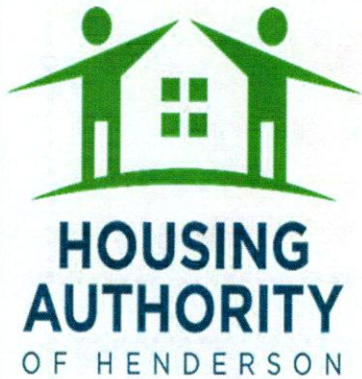
Healthy Eating Tips
