As July 4 approaches, you and your children are probably thinking about sitting out in your yard with family and neighbors, eating barbecue, and watching beautiful fireworks bursting in the night sky. July 4 celebrations can be a lot of fun.

For your enjoyment, Henderson Municipal Gas, Independence Bank, and the Henderson Tourist Commission will sponsor a Fireworks celebration on July 3, 2025, from 5:00 to 9:30 p.m. at the Henderson Riverfront.

Food vendors open at 5:00 P.M.; children's activities begin at 6:00 P.M. Live music from the Old Dam Community Band starts at 6:30 PM. The fireworks show begins at approx. 9:15 PM

To ensure that you and your children have both a fun and safe July 4, please observe these fireworks safety tips:

- Obey all local laws regarding the use of fireworks -
- Ensure all pets and animals are away from the noise of fireworks.
- Avoid sparklers. They can potentially catch clothing on fire.
- Never attempt to make your own fireworks.
- Keep yourself and your child away from other people who are using sparklers or lighting their own fireworks; bystanders are more frequently injured by fireworks than the people who use them.
- Have water nearby for emergencies and for pouring on fireworks.
- Know where the closest phone is located, or carry a cell phone in case a fire occurs, and the fire department is needed.

Remember – use of fireworks of any type on Housing Authority property is prohibited.

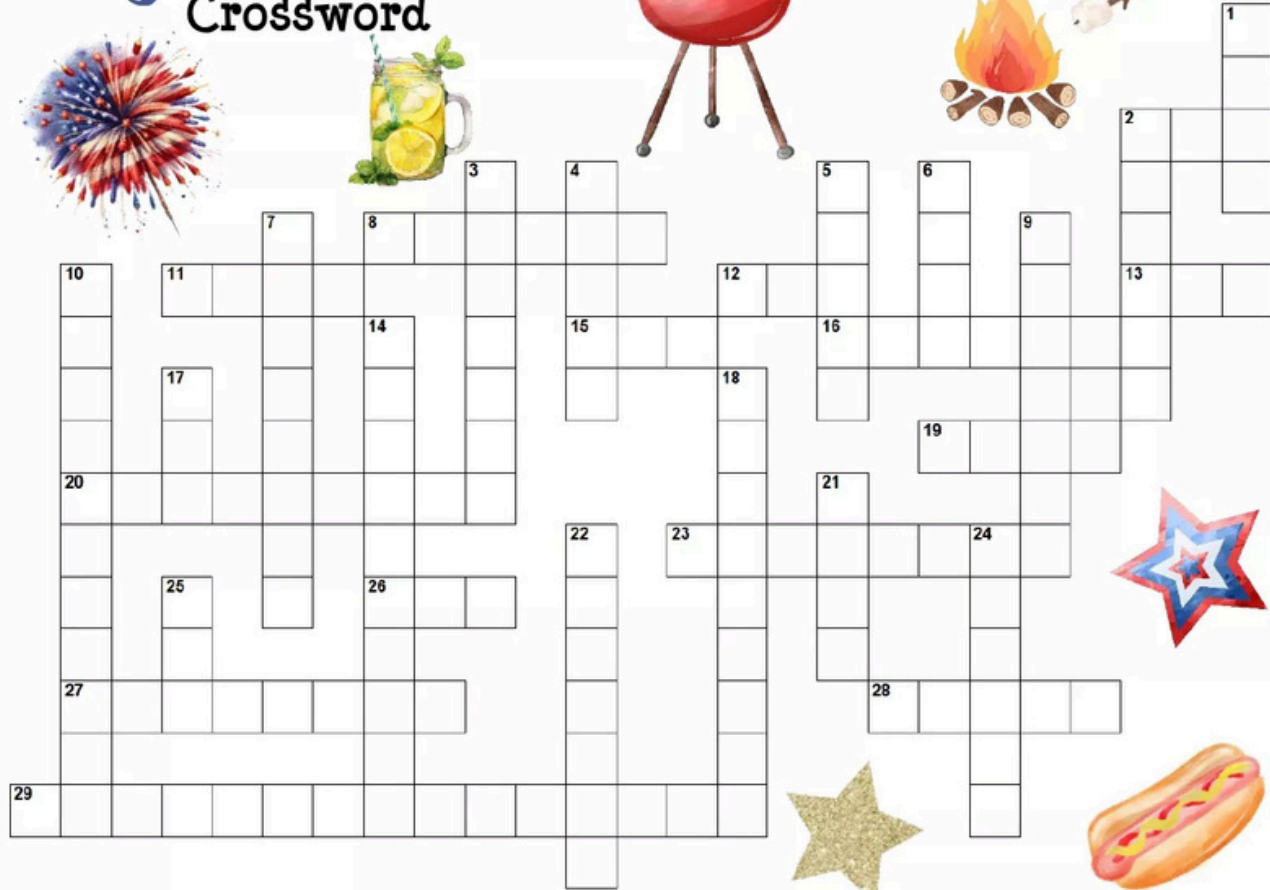
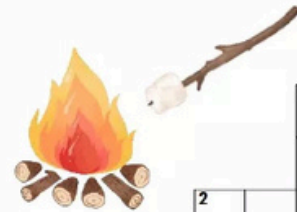

Inspections:

The HUD Inspection has still not been scheduled for Dixon, and Madison. The month of July we are not inspecting Fagan, Dixon and Ingram, and the three houses. If we get any addition HUD information, we will let you know as soon as possible. If you live at Lawndale, Dixon, and Madison, please continue to call in work order as needed.

Lawndale inspections will be July 22 and 23, 2026.

Setting off fireworks is not permitted on Housing Authority Properties.

No SWIMMING POOLS are allowed!

Children are out of school please slow down when you are driving through the developments.

Complaints-If you are having an issue with a neighbor who is breaking the law call the police department, and give your manager a written complaint, without a written complaint it restricts the Property Manager in enforcing the lease.

Reminder: Pets-resident is responsible to pick up pet waste as it occurs.

Parking- Do not park cars on the grass or sidewalks. Sidewalks are for walking or bike riding.

Please bag all trash and tie it closed to keep the smell down and flies out when throwing it in the dumpsters.

Please remember that car washing, pools, or hooking hoses or sprinklers with water from your apt is not allowed, per your lease.

As in accordance with your lease, residents have 14 days per year of visitation. This is a total of all visitors, each day. If you would like to add someone to your lease, contact our office. Violators will be given a lease violation notice. Residents who allow guests to stay past the 14 day limit are subject to lease termination.

Reminder HUD implemented a rule that requires all Housing Authorities to have a smoke free policy, effective June 5, 2017. This policy states no smoking in any Public Housing Apartment is allowed and smoking outside must be 25 feet away from and door or window.

We will terminate leases of those who continue to smoke in the non-smoking apartments.
